Silent Dessert Auction



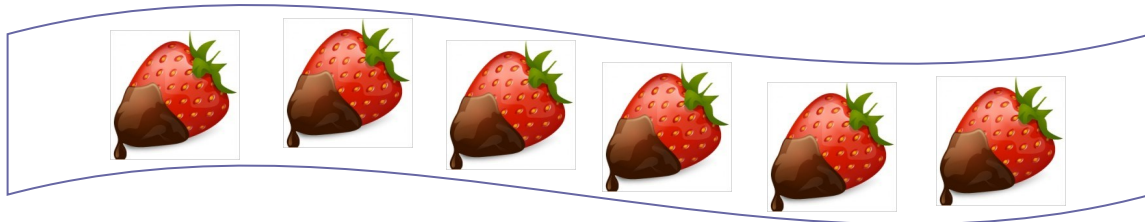
You're invited to peruse the tasty selection of desserts in Fellowship Hall, made by members and friends of the church. Each dessert starts with a \$2 bid.
